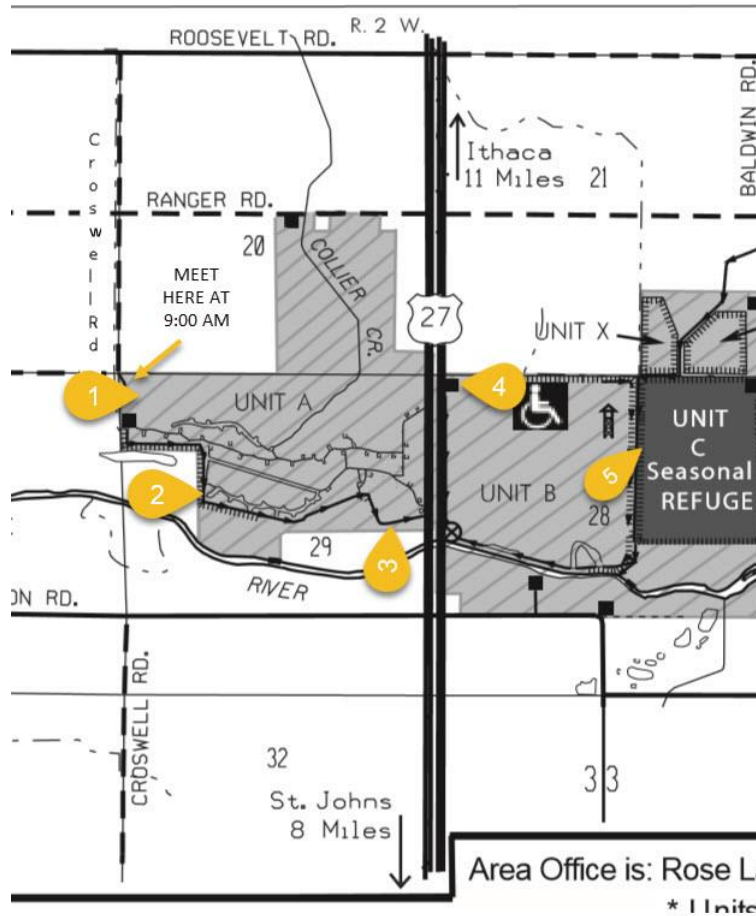
#1 - Parking lot; Warbler, Cuckoo, Woodpecker, Flycatcher, Vireo, boat launch

#2 - Spillway; Warbler (Prothonotary nest), Vireo, Sora/Rail, Waterfowl, Gull, Tern, Osprey, Eagle, Otter

#3 - Dike; Bald Eagle nest, Waterfowl, Gull, Tern, Warbler

#4 - Parking lot; Rough trail along the guardrail near parking lot, boat launch, eastward dike is not that exciting, but leads to the Tower

#5 - Dike; Shorebird, Marsh Wren, Swamp Sparrow, Waterfowl, Gull, Tern, Osprey, Eagle

#1 - Parking lot; Warbler, Flycatcher, Shorebird, Shrike (fall & winter), boat launch

#2 - Unit X & Y; Waterfowl, Shorebird, Swamp Sparrow, Osprey nest

#3 - Dike; Shorebird, Marsh Wren, Swamp Sparrow, Waterfowl, Gull, Tern, Osprey, Eagle

#4 - Dike; Shorebird, Marsh Wren, Swamp Sparrow, Sora/Rail, Bittern, Waterfowl, Gull, Tern, Osprey, Eagle

#5 - 2 track to river; Clay Colored/Savannah Sparrow, Bobolink, Oriole, Kingbird, Tanager, Flycatcher, Eagle, Waterfowl, Shorebird, Marsh Wren, Sora/Rail, Owl can be heard at dusk, Harrier (fall & winter), Shrike (fall & winter)

#6 - Grassland near maintenance sheds; Clay Colored/Savannah Sparrow, Bobolink, Dickcissel, Shrike (fall & winter), Harrier (fall & winter), Long & Short Eared Owl (fall & winter)
